

Social Media Policy

The North West Cricket League recognises the majority of players, club officials and club members make use of the various forms of social media, and understand comments will be made on cricket in general, the running of the NWCL and specific matches.

However, the contents of the posts may be seen by people with no or little interest in cricket or the NWCL so as far as is reasonably practical we would expect posts to be informed and relevant.

The NWCL will take disciplinary action if it is reported that posts breach the ECB guidelines in the following areas.

1. The posts include threatening, abusive or foul language.
2. The posts are discriminatory.
3. The game of cricket or the NWCL is brought into disrepute.

Reported posts from players, officials and others connected with a club will be dealt with under the ECB guidelines.
