

Rule 18 (10) Development Division

~~The Duckworth Lewis method of calculating revised targets will not be used in the Development Section. Instead the revised targets will be calculated as follows:-~~

~~Divide the number of runs scored in the first innings by the number of overs received in order to arrive at the first innings runs per over rate. (For this purpose, any part over will constitute a full over). In the event of a side being dismissed within the total of number of overs that it was entitled to receive in the time allotted for the first innings, the run rate will be calculated by dividing the runs scored by the total number of overs that the team was entitled to receive rather than the number of overs actually received. The scoring rate is calculated to two decimal places with rounding off as follows from 1 to 4 down, from 5 to 9 up.~~

~~Calculate 75% of the runs per over rate from (a).~~

~~Multiply the reduced run rate by the number of overs lost in the second innings and if not a whole number round up to the next whole number.~~

~~Calculate the reduced tie/winning target to be achieved by the team batting second by deducting the figure in (c) from the first innings total. The result will give you runs required to tie, add one to this total to calculate the winning target.~~

~~If after the commencement of the second innings further time/~~

Rules regarding rain affected games in shall be as per the full league rules with the following variations:-

1 - No overs will be lost for the first 20 minutes lost time in the first innings.

2 - Should the start time be changed from 1pm the count back time for overs remaining in the 2nd innings (7.10pm)

will be adjusted accordingly.

Rule 7 (2)

Time of arrival: Umpires must be on the ground at least ~~30~~ 45 minutes before play is due to commence.

Rule 10 (32) *New Rule*

No Balls: All No Balls will result in a Free Hit, no changes in the fielding positions allowed other than if the batsman change ends. Fielders within the fielding circle allowed to move back to the edge of that circle

No game shall be called off before the normal starting time, except with the concurrence of both Captains and both Umpires in attendance at the ground; or, if in the opinion of the home captain, conditions are so bad that play will be impossible, then the following procedure may be followed;-

- a) The home captain informs both appointed umpires and the opposition captain, who, is then given the option to meet at the ground with one of the appointed umpires, or a designated league umpire who lives nearby to discuss and decide; or
- b) Is sent a photograph via a mobile/pc and a designated umpire meets the home captain to verify that in both their opinions play will not be possible.
- c) If the opposition captain is not in agreement, he then has the right to override this decision, and with his team, travel to the ground for the said start of play. The normal process will then apply.
- d) The process is to start two and a half hours before the scheduled start.

The appointed umpires must be kept informed of all developments and must be notified immediately if the game is called off.

3 (2)

Any proposition to the League Secretary for the League A.G.M. from a club, **member of the executive, or Umpires Association**, shall only be accepted for the Agenda if there is a Secunder for it from another club, in writing, subject to the same deadline. Notice of any proposed alterations for discussion at the A.G.M. shall be forwarded to the Secretary of each club by October 31st. Amendments to such proposals for the A.G.M. shall be received by the Secretary with a Secunder in writing by 14th November. Proposals from clubs must be signed by two officials. Voting entitlement at an (Annual) General Meeting is as follows:

- a) One vote to each Club.
- b) One vote to the Umpires' Association.
- c) One vote to the Junior League Committee.
- d) The Chairman of such meeting shall not vote except in the case of an equality of votes when he shall be entitled to exercise a casting vote.
- e) No member Club which has applied for membership of another League shall be entitled to vote on resolutions laid before any Annual General Meeting whilst such application is pending.
